

Proclamation

WHEREAS, we, people of diverse religions, spiritual expressions and indigenous traditions throughout the world, established the UNITED RELIGIONS INITIATIVE (URI) to promote enduring, daily Interfaith cooperation, to end religiously motivated violence and to create cultures of peace, justice and healing for the Earth and all living beings; and

WHEREAS, we are living in a world of nations whose interdependence makes unity and respect for diversity a priority for the survival and advancement of our civilization; and

WHEREAS, the issue of peace embraces the deepest hopes of all peoples and remains humanity's guiding inspiration; and

WHEREAS, in 1981 the United Nations proclaimed that the International Day of Peace would be "devoted to commemorating and strengthening the ideals of peace both within and among all nations and peoples"; and

WHEREAS, the United Nations expanded the observance of the International Day of Peace in 2001 to include the call for a day of global ceasefire and non-violence, and invited all nations and people to honor a cessation of hostilities for the duration of the Day; and

WHEREAS, there is growing support among members of our organization throughout the world for the observance of the International Day of Peace, which affirms a vision of a healthy world at peace, and fosters cooperation among individuals, organizations and nations; and

WHEREAS, URI is committed to join hands with the United Nations and people around the world in pledging its commitment to peace and interfaith harmony, to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and to justice and healing for the earth and all living beings, on this day and always; and

WHEREAS, global crises impel all citizens to work toward converting humanity's noblest aspirations for world peace into a practical reality for future generations,

THEREFORE, in active demonstration of understanding, unity, cooperation and peace, we, members of the UNITED RELIGIONS INITIATIVE throughout the world, do hereby join the United Nations to proclaim September 21, as

"The International Day of Peace".

Throughout the world where we have URI members, we urge all our members to encourage all citizens of this world to work together to create peace, justice and healing for the Earth and for all living beings.
